

TISS Junior Faculty Research Support Grants

The Triangle Institute for Security Studies has a small fund available to support the research programs of the junior faculty who are members of the TISS community. Members are encouraged to apply for small grants of up to \$500. There will be two funding cycles, with proposals due 15 August and 15 December of each year and awards granted as funding permits. Under special circumstances, off-cycle proposals may also be considered.

The grants are intended to facilitate the research of junior faculty who are members of TISS. Appropriate proposals might include (but are not limited to): requests for funding research-related travel; requests for funding travel to present research in academic venues; requests for paying research assistants; other research-related expenses.

A sub-committee of the TISS Executive Committee will meet on an ad-hoc basis to review the proposals.

Priority will be given to:

- * proposals from faculty in tenure-track positions.
- * proposals from faculty who have not already received a grant that academic year.
- * proposals for projects for which there are not ready alternative sources of funding.
- * proposals for projects that fit within the TISS mission to promote communication and cooperation among faculty, graduate students, and the public across disciplines and beyond the confines of each university in order to advance research and education concerning national and international security, broadly defined.

Proposals should include:

- * one page description of the project
- * budget and justification for expenses. Justification should note efforts made to secure alternative funding.
- * updated c.v.
